LOCALLY-RECRUITED TEAM

- Our “invited-guest attitude” combined with a traditional partnership.
- Anesthesia Healthcare Partners® (AHP) can finance the startup and own the anesthesia practice.

VALUE-ADDED BENEFITS

- **Malpractice coverage**
All anesthesia team members will carry malpractice coverage, which will match the centers financial coverage.
- **Policy and procedure manual**
A manual will be maintained at each site and will be incorporated into the facilities policy and procedures.
- **Equipment**
AHP will supply its own monitors and equipment, unless the facility desires to use their present equipment (dependent upon facility type).
- **Recruitment**
Providers will be recruited from the local area, but we will also look to national sources for top providers.
- **Qualified and credentialed anesthesia professionals**
Providers will have a full background check before they are presented to the center. If an anesthesiologist is on staff, they will be Board Certified or within the Board system.
- **Access to AHP management**
